in and by my certain promissory note in writing, of even date with these presents, am well and truly indebted to

Chicora Bank, Pelzer, S.C.

in the full and just sum of Twelve hundred six and 77/100 dollars

Dollars, to be paid November 1st, 1927.

with interest thereon, from maturity at the rate of 8 per cent. per annum, to be computed and paid annually.

.....until paid in full, all interest to and when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note, to become immediately due at the option of the holder hereof, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage, said note further providing for an attorney's fee of Three per cent.

.....besides all costs and expenses of collection to be added to the amount due on said note, to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part thereof, be collected by an attorney or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which are secured under this mortgage; as in and by the said note, reference being thereunto had, as will more fully appear.)

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That

in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said Chicora Bank,

according to the terms of said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars, to me, the said J. L. Coker,

in hand well and truly paid by the said Chicora Bank, Pelzer, S.C.

at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents, do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Chicora Bank, Pelzer, S.C. & its successors and assigns,

all that certain piece, parcel or tract of land, situated, in Grove and Oaklawn township, County and State aforesaid, containing (41- $\frac{1}{2}$ %) Forty one and  $\frac{1}{2}$  acres more or less, being more particular described as follows: Beginning on stone in road on Jassies Slates line, thence N. 44° E. 5.95 to stone #1 at old corner P.O. stump; thence N. 16- $\frac{1}{2}$  W. 21.35 to corner on Garrison line, thence N. 68- $\frac{1}{2}$  W. 3.80 to stone in drain, thence S. 35° W. 10.75 to stone #2, thence N. 67- $\frac{1}{2}$  W. 15.10 to stone in road, thence with road S. 2 $\frac{1}{2}$  E. 13.95 to stone in some road, thence S. 86° C. 14.05 to stone #3, thence S. 2 $\frac{1}{2}$  E. 7.91 to stone in road, thence due E. 11.20 to beginning corner, adjoining land of W.
