

map; thence continuing down the river with the meanders of said contour line to a stake on said contour line, and in J. O. Bell's line between Stations 104 and 105 on said Padshaw map; thence with said Bell's line, South $72^{\circ} 15'$ West about 60 feet to a stake, Bell's corner; thence South $39^{\circ} 45'$ West 84.2 feet, South $26.15'$ West 312 feet; north $44^{\circ} 30'$ West 136 feet to a maple; thence South $7^{\circ} 45'$ West 417.8 feet to a chestnut, South 12.55 East 275.6 feet to Spruce pine; thence South $46.15'$ East 170 feet to said contour line between Stations 119 and 120 on said Padshaw map; thence with the meanders of said contour line to a stake north of road in line of Green River Mfg. Company, about 150 feet from the black gum corner between Stations 132 and 133 of said contour line; thence South 15.05 East to Black gum at Green River thence South 5.15 East to center of river; thence up the river with its meanders about 1640 feet to a point opposite stake in South bank near the mouth of small branch on South side of river, corner of Green River Mfg. Company and P. J. Hart's; thence South $59.45'$ East to a stake in said contour line about 200 feet between Stations 5-41 and 5-42, Padshaw Map; thence with meanders of said contour line to the Beginning Stone no. 5-52, near South east end of said dam; containing 70.8 acres, more or less also, all of those rights, privileges and easements conveyed by J. O. Bell and others to the Green River Mfg. Company by deed dated Dec. 26, 1907, and of record in Book 61, page 5-95, of the records of deeds for Henderson County, and embraced within the following described boundary to-wit;

Beginning at a stake in the western boundary line of the C. T. Staton 7 acre tract, South side of river, where the water line contour elevation 2010 feet datum here in before referred to crosses said boundary line, it being the fourth corner of that tract of land above described, and runs up Green River, South side, and with meanders of said contour line, as shown by map heretofore referred to, about 4000 feet measured in a straight line to the limit of back water in Green River from the dam of the said Green River Manufacturing Company, thence down said river, North side, with the meanders
