

N. 26. 13- W. 334 feet to stake; thence N. 24. 07 E. 141 feet to stake; thence N. 14. 45 E. 274 feet to stake on contour elevation 925 (reference U. S. G. S. B. M. 1052, near Hamilton Bridge); thence with the meanders of said contour elevation 925 feet, in a westerly and southerly direction, over the lands deeded by C. H. Kruppe and others to Joseph Lee, September 26, 1907, and recorded in Register's Office, Polk County, in Book 24, page 26, and from David A. Thompson and others to Joseph Lee, December 21st, 1908, and recorded in Book 26, page 560, Office Register of Deeds, Polk County, to a small branch; thence crossing said branch and continuing with said contour elevation 925 feet in a north westerly direction to line between the Thompson Tract and lands of Joseph Melton; thence with Melton's line N. 1 $\frac{1}{4}$ E. about 700 feet to Green River; thence with the said river, in a north westerly direction, about 1500 feet to the line between lands of Joseph Melton and the J. B. Turner Tract; thence with said Melton line S. $\frac{1}{2}$ W. about 250 feet to point on contour elevation 925 feet; thence with the meanders of said contour line in a westerly and southerly direction until it intersects Silver Creek; thence crossing said creek and continuing said contour elevation line 925 feet in a north westerly direction to the line between the Turner Tract and the McKraw Tract about 200 feet from Green River and near the mouth of Silver Creek, passing over lands deeded by J. B. Turner to Manufacturers Power Company, May, 24, 1922, and recorded in Book # 142, page 181, and tract deeded by Rufus and Annanda Collins to manufacturers Power Co. Jan. 5, 1917, and recorded in Book # 36, page 16; said Register's Office; thence continuing with said contour elevation line 925 feet in a south westerly direction over lands deeded by J. A. McKraw to Manufacturers Power Co. Dec. 19, 1913 and recorded in Book # 32, page 370, Register's Office for said County, to the J. B. Turner Tract; thence continuing with said contour elevation line 925 feet in a north westerly direction over lands conveyed by J. B. Turner to manufacturers Power Co. by deed recorded in said Register's Office in Deed Book # 23, page 219, to the Hamilton Tract;
