 computed and paid until paid in full, all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note..... become immediately due at the option of the holder hereof, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; said note further providing for an attorney's fee of one hundred dollars besides all costs and expenses of collection to be added to the amount due on said note..... to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part thereof, be collected by an attorney or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage; as in and by the said note....., reference being thereunto had, as will more fully appear.)

 at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents, do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said W. W. Pollard

All that certain piece parcel and tract of land being and lying in the state and county aforesaid, containing Eighty three and 5/10 acres, more or less and being situated about one and 1/2 miles west of Fountain Inn, S.C. with the following metes and bounds to wit:—

Beginning at a point in centre of road leading from Ft. Inn to Debus at a point adjoining lands of E. E. Gary and Ernest Armstrong, and running thence along said road N. 60° E. 9.39 to centre of road; thence S. 68° E. 2.92 to W. D.
