in the full and just sum of Eight Thousand Three Hundred Eighty five and 37/100 Dollars, to be paid in one hundred forty five monthly installments of Fifty seven and 15/100 Dollars each, on the first day of each month, and beginning on the first day of March 1923 and for so long thereafter until all the principal and interest thereon is paid, at the rate of 7 per cent. per annum to be computed and paid annually

until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage, said note further providing for an attorney's fee of

7 per cent on any unpaid balance besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to the amount due on said note to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part thereof, be collected by an attorney or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by the said note, reference being thereto had, as will more fully appear.

at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said

All of that certain piece, parcel or tract of land, containing fifteen acres, more or less, and situate, lying and being about three one one-half miles rock back of the City of Greenville, County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, and being in White Oak Church, and having the following metes and bounds according to a plat of same, made by P. C. Dalton, Civil Engineer, dated June, 1922: Beginning at an iron pin in the center of a community road, separating the herein described lands from lands owned now or formerly by the Douglass estate, and running S. 82-12 E. 117 feet to an iron pin, thence, S. 4-30 E. 588.4 feet to an iron pin on H. S. Bradley's line; thence, N. 86-30 E. 600 feet on a line said H. S. Bradley's line to an iron pin; thence N. 77-25 E. 360.3 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 4-56 E. 620 feet to the point of beginning; said tract of land being a part of a tract of land containing 43 1/4 acres, more or less; conveyed to the said H.
