computed and paid *Annually*.

until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal, and if any portion of principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage, said note further providing for an attorney's fee of *per cent (0.050)*  
~~additional on said debt~~ besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to the amount due on said note, to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part thereof, be collected by an attorney or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by the said note, reference being thereunto had, as will more fully appear.

at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents do grant, bar-

gain, sell and release unto the said *B.G. Langford*, all that piece  
parcel and tract of land lying situated in  
Bates' farm his, arod the State and County a-  
foreaid, and containing about (58) fifty-eight  
acres the same more or less. It shall be fol-  
lowing metes and bounds, to wit. Beginning  
at C. C. Bates' corner at the Greenville and Northern  
Rail Road, and running N. 69 $\frac{3}{4}$  E. about 8.00  
chains to a stone, thence N. 65 E. 13.90 chains  
to a stone, thence N. 49 W. 37.75 chains to a  
stone; thence S. 24 W. 9.25 chains to a stone;  
thence S. 47 $\frac{1}{4}$  W. about 750 chains to the corner of  
C. C. Bates' and A. J. Bates' land at the S. W.  
P. R. thence running a southeasterly course  
with C. C. Bates' line, and the S. W. P. R. to the  
beginning corner. This is a part of the land  
conveyed to me by D. F. Cunningham in 1905.  
This is the part that lies North of the S. W.  
P. R. Adjoining lands of C. C. Bates, S. M. Goldsmith,  
Tom Mc Cauley Estate, and Cunningham Estate.  
These metes and bounds were taken from  
a Plat made by H. A. Hudson, 1901. The plat  
showed the South of Rail Road which is al-  
ready sold off.
