All that certain lot or parcel of land sit-
 uate, lying and being in the City of Green-
 ville, S.C. on the southern side of Ridgeland
 Avenue, it being known and designated as
 lot No. 11 of Cleveland Terrace, as shown on a
 plat made by Dalton & Neves, Engineers; and
 having, according to said plat the follow-
 ing metes and bounds, to-wit:

Beginning at an iron pin in the Southern
 line of Ridgeland Avenue, the joint corner
 of lots Nos. 10 and 11 and running thence
 with the joint line of said lots S. 23-33 $\frac{1}{2}$
 199.7 feet to an iron pin in the northern
 line of a 15 foot alley; thence with said alley
 S. 69-18 $\frac{1}{2}$ 65 feet to an iron pin corner of lot
