WHEREAS, I, the said Mrs Bettie Satterfield
in and by my certain Promissory note in writing, of
even date with these presents, am well and truly indebted to

in the full and just sum of Sixty-four (\$64.00)
Dollars, to be paid November, 15, 1928

with interest thereon, from maturity at the rate of eight per cent. per annum to be
computed and paid annually

until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or
interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may
sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage, said note further providing for an attorney's fee of

Twenty-five (\$25.00) besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be
added to the amount due on said note, to be collectible as part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part
thereof, be collected by an attorney or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by the said note, reference being
thereunto had, as will more fully appear.

gain, sell and release unto the said N. K. Townes, his heirs and assigns forever
All my right, title and interest in and to the
same being an undivided one-third interest,
All that certain tract of land in Gantt Town-
ship, Greenville County, South Carolina, about
four miles from Greenville Court House, on
the Stanton Bridge Road, and containing about
fifty acres, being tract No. 2 of the John Satter-
field Land, acquired by me from John B. Satter-
field, my deceased husband, who died in
testate, being same land conveyed to said
John B. Satterfield by Charles A. Satterfield and
others, by deed dated July 21, 1906, recorded
in Deed Book 117, page 256, R. M. C. Office for Greenv-
ille County. There is no other mortgage lien,
except a mortgage of twelve hundred (\$1200.00)
Dollars thereon.
