I, Frank Zupan

SEND GREETING:

WHEREAS, I, *Frank Zupan*, the said *Frank Zupan*, in and by my certain Commissioner, even date with these presents, *Frank Zupan*, well and truly indebted to *Townes & Wells*, in the full and just sum of *Fifteen Hundred (\$1,500.00) Dollars*, to be paid *One year from date*.

with interest thereon, from *date* at the rate of *eight* per cent. per annum to be computed and paid *Semi-annually*.

until paid in full, all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage, said note further providing for an attorney's fee of *ten per cent*.

besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to the amount due on said note, to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part thereof, be collected by an attorney or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by the said note, reference being thereto had, as will more fully appear.

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That *Frank Zupan*, the said *Frank Zupan*, in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said *Townes & Wells*,

according to the terms of the said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars, to me, the said *Frank Zupan*, in hand well and truly paid by the said *Townes & Wells*.

at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said *Townes & Wells*, their heirs and

assignees forever, ~~it is agreed~~ that certain tract of land situated in Gant Township, County and State of South Carolina containing forty-six & one-half (46 1/2) acres more or less lying and being on the Saluda River at the Dunham Bridge, and adjoining property of D. F. Hollingsworth and others being the same tract conveyed to Frank Zupan by W. P. Conyers and T. C. Gour, by deed dated August 4, 1917, recorded in Vol. 73, page 252, referred to this deed is hereby made.

And also, all that tract of land situated on the North side of the Anderson Road at Dunham Bridge and having the following metes and bounds, to wit:

Beginning at a water oak 3x0 on the east side of the Dunham Bridge and thence running with the line of the old Anderson Road two (2) chains to a bend; thence with said road 5 chains to a bend; thence 3.15 Chs. to a bend; thence 3.20 Chs. to a bend; thence 4 Chs. to a bend; thence 1.25 Chs. to an iron stake in the middle of the road, at Hollingsworth's corner; thence 14-1/2 W. 8 Chs. to a stake in the middle of the new road leading towards the river; thence 8 Chs. to a bend; in said road; thence stile with the said road 1.97 Chs. to the middle of the bridge over branch, thence down the branch 3 Chs. to a stake on the bank of the Saluda River; thence down the same to the beginning corner being the same tract conveyed to Frank Zupan by Henry P. McFee by deed dated August 4, 1923, recorded in Vol. 76, page 176, R.M.C. Office for said Greenville County.
