17th DAY OF MAY 1891

with interest thereon, from date of instrument at the rate of 8 per cent. per annum to be computed and paid Annually

until paid in full all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount advanced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage, said note further providing for an attorney's fee of Ten per cent.

besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to the amount due on said note, to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part thereof, be collected by an attorney or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by the said note, reference being thereto had, as will more fully appear.

Mahaffey*, according to the tenor of the said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars, to me, the said *I. H. Dill*, hand well and truly paid by the said *J. J. Mahaffey*

at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said *J. J. Mahaffey his heirs and*

assigns, all that Certain piece or tract of land situate lying and being in the State and County of ~~Greenville~~ said in the town of Traveler's Rest, Containing Seven tenths ($\frac{7}{10}$) acres more or less on the North side of the Greenville & Western Railway tracks and having the following metes and bounds, to wit, Beginning at a stake 3xw and line running parallel with said Railway track and Fifty feet from the inside of the track thereof and running thence North 59° E. Three Hundred (300) feet to a stake 3xw on the street 30 feet wide thence along side of said street N. 31° W. One Hundred (100) feet to a stake #xn; thence S. 59° W. Three Hundred (300) feet to a stake 3xw on said parallel line running Fifty feet from middle of Railway track, thence S. 31° W. One Hundred (100) feet with said line to the beginning corner, and being known as Lot No. 13 and 14 original map of a block of lots as surveyed by J. N. Southern, D. S. on the 12th Day of Feb 1891; being bounded on East by lots nos. 15 and 16 and on the West by lots nos. 11 and 12.
