WITNESSETH, Whereas, the said party of the first part is indebted to said MECHANICS BUILDING AND LOAN ASSOCIATION in the sum of \$1,000.00 due April 1st, 1928, and no day thereafter.

Now, therefore, in consideration of the premises, and in further consideration of one dollar to him in hand paid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, the said party of the first part has granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said party of the second part all that certain piece, parcel and lot of land lying in Greenville County, in the State of South Carolina, as follows:

In Greenville Township, on Easley Bridge Road, known as lot No. 52 on plat of R. M. C. of Estate of J. Rawley Young made by Dalton & Morris, Engineers, recorded in Plat Book Page, having the following metes and bounds: Beginning at an iron pin on Easley Bridge Road, 90 feet west of Lark Avenue, corner of Lot 51, and running thence along line of lot 51 S. 30-55 E. 200 feet to iron pin in line of lot 53; thence with line of said lot S. 60-00 W. 100 feet to iron pin, corner of lot 69; thence with line of said lot N. 30-55 W. 200 feet to iron pin on Easley Bridge Road, thence with said road N. 60-00 E. 100 feet to the beginning corner, being the same conveyed to me by Julia D.
