For Value Received, we, Nathaniel B. Barnwell, South Carolina Historical Society and Nath B. Barnwell, as substituted Trustee under the Will of Robert L. Brodie, deceased, owners and holders of a certain mortgage executed by Carpenter Bros. Drug Company to Joseph H. Barnwell on December 5, 1921, recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Mortgages, Volume 42 at Page 373, and securing the sum of Twelve Thousand (\$12,000.00) Dollars, do hereby release and forever discharge from the lien of said mortgage the following described premises, to-wit: -

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being at the southeast intersection of North Main and Oak Streets in the City of Greenville, County and State aforesaid and having, according to a survey made by C. M. Furman, Jr. Engineer, January 18, 1929, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

Beginning at an iron pin at the southeast intersection of North Main and Oak Streets and running thence along the southern side of Oak Street, S. 68-04 E. 113.59 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 18-30 W. 40.1 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 68-04 W. 114.42 feet to an iron pin in the line of North Main Street; thence along the Eastern side of North Main Street, N. 19-51 E. 40 feet to the point of beginning.
