All that certain lot or piece of land situate, lying and being in the City of Greenville, Greenville County, in the State of South Carolina near the Greenville Depot, beginning at a stake 34 on Vardry Street, and running thence with said Street S. 74 E. one hundred and seventeen and one-half (117 1/2) feet to stake 34; thence N. 72-2 E. Eighty-four (84) feet to a stake 34 on a street forty-eight feet wide, thence along said Street N. 20 3/4 W. Two hundred and forty (240) feet to a stake 34 on a street fifty (50) feet wide, running S. 26 1/2 W. thence along the said Street S. 26 1/2 W. Two hundred and fifty three (253) feet to the beginning corner, containing two (2) rods and eleven poles, more or less, in including all buildings and improvements thereon, bounded by Green Avenue, Vardry Street and Markley Street, as shown on the City Map in the auditor's office page 73, as the property of the Allen Temple A.
