H. Tally and shown on Plat of said Property made by W. M. Raat, Engineer and recorded in the office of the ~~office~~ of the R. M. C. of Greenville County in Plat Book, N. at Page 116, and having the following metes and bounds: Beginning at an iron Pin 200 Pin feet from Bennett Street and running thence with East side of broft Street, fifty (50) feet to an iron Pin ; thence N. 19-21 E. 114 feet to iron Pin ; thence N. 70-30 W. 50 feet to iron Pin ; thence S. 19-30 W. 114 feet to beginning corner on broft Street.

Also all that certain Piece, Parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in the same Property of L. H.
