WHEREAS, I, the said *Lillian G. Lewis*, in and by my certain promissory note in writing, of even date with these presents, am well and truly indebted to

in the full and just sum of Thirty-two (\$3,200.00)
Dollars, to be paid Anet year after date

with interest thereon, from date Battle July 18, 1941, Earle at the rate of eight per cent. per annum to be computed and paid annually, Frank

until paid in full all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage, said note further providing for an attorney's fee of ~~Five per cent of amount~~

~~plus reasonable expenses~~ besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to the amount due on said note, to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part thereof, be collected by an attorney or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by the said note, reference being thereto had, will more fully appear.

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That I, the said *Lillian G. Lewis*, in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said *Frank St. Earle*,

according to the terms of the said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars, to ~~me~~, the said *Lillian G. Lewis*

in hand well and truly paid by the said *Frank St. Earle*

at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents do grant,

bargain, sell and release unto the said *Frank St. Earle*, his heirs and assigns, all those two certain lots of land lying in the County and State aforesaid, and described as follows: Lot No. 1 Lying in the City of Greenville, and having the following metes and bounds: Beginning at a point skiped inplement step on north side of Bumcombe street, joint corner of lot to which *Lillian G. Lewis* has conveyed her undivided one-half interest to Nelle G. Jenkins, and running thence N. 27° 35' E. 143.65 feet to a point in line of property of *Lillian Lewis* and Nelle G. Jenkins; thence with line of said lot No. 53-22 N. 29.8 feet to a point at the corner of Owings lot; thence with line of Owings lot S. 26-30 W. 113.8 feet to a point on Bumcombe street; thence with the north line of Bumcombe street S. 32-00 E. 30-55 feet to the beginning corner, as will more fully appear by plat of the property of Mrs. *Lillian Lewis* and Mrs. N. G. Jenkins, dated November 15, 1922 and recorded in R.M.C. Office, said County and State, in Plat Bk., Vol., Page . This lot is a part of the original Mary K. Stake property and referenced hereby granted to Deed Book 60, Page 243, R.M.C. Office for Greenville County, South Carolina. Lot No. 2 All that certain tract of land in Austin Township, County and State aforesaid, on Tidders Creek, waters of Crore River, containing ninety-six and eight tenths (96.8) acres, more or less. Beginning at middle of Tidders Creek at corner of land conveyed by *Lillian Lewis* to Nelle G. Jenkins; thence N. 18° 45' by a poplar and a spring 1979 feet, more or less, to the middle of Anderson Bridge Road near a stone; thence with the middle of Anderson Bridge Road in a N. W. direction 1979 feet, more or less to a corner on lands of Jessie C. Kilgore; thence with his line S. 6-2/3 E. 2121 feet, more or less, to middle of Tidders Creek at mouth of branch; thence with Tidders Creek in an approximately Eastern direction 3800 feet, more or less, to the beginning corner. Being a portion of Lot No. 1, in a division of the lands of Josiah Kilgore, deceased, as is shown by plat made by Jas. A. Dickson c. E. May 17, 1877. The above tract of land is bounded on the North by lands of T. P. Cox; East by lands of Caroline (Higher) Estate; South by lands conveyed to Nelle G. Jenkins by *Lillian Lewis*; and on the West by lands of Jessie C. Kilgore.
