bargain, sell and release unto the said Peoples National Bank, Greenville, its

successors and assigns: All that certain tract of land

part of Tract No 6, as shown by the partition of the Estate  
of Mrs. Kesiah Miller, Deed, made by Commissioners in Partition  
June 17, 1921, in accordance with a sub-division and plat of said  
property made by C. M. Turman, Jr. in August 1919, said plat being  
recorded in the R. M. C. Office for the County and State aforesaid  
in Plat Book "E," at page 160, and more particularly described  
as follows: Beginning in Simpsonville road near an oak, which  
point of beginning is in the line of tract 5 thence along said  
road S. 70.31 E. 10.98; thence along said road S. 72.30 E. 8.71; thence

20.15 W. 4.75 to stone; thence S. 87.45 W. 11.94 to stone; thence S. 13.30 E.  
0.50 to pipe at corner of tract No 4; thence along the line of tract  
No 4 S. 3.45 E. 11.42 to pipe at corner of tract No 5; thence along  
the line of tract No 5, S. 3.45 E. 43.22 to the beginning corner,  
and containing 128.20 acres, more or less, and being the tract

in partition of the estate of Mrs. Kesiah Miller, Deed as shown by the
