per cent. per annum, payable weekly,  
the payment whereof the said party of the first part is anxious to secure:

Now, therefore, in consideration of the premises, and in further consideration of one dollar to ~~Mr~~ in hand paid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, the  
said party of the first part has granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said party of the second part all  
that certain piece, parcel and lot of land lying in Greenville County, in the State aforesaid, as follows, to-wit:

*Lot No. 8, Section 30, Greenville County, South Carolina, being the Eastern Half of the Cedar Lane Road about  
one-half mile west of the Greenville County Court House and  
of Lot No. 8 in Section 30, designated as the Cedar Lane Road  
boundary, running the following stakes and  
boundaries, to-wit: Beginning at a point on the  
North side of Cedar Lane Road, corner of lot No.  
1, sold ~~to~~ to R. S. Henson, which point is  
52 $\frac{1}{2}$  feet from the corner of Lots Nos. 1 and 8 on a  
mention plat, and running thence along line  
of Henson lot N. 9 $\frac{1}{2}$  E. 210 feet to a point in back line,
