WITNESSETH, Whereas, the said party of the first part is indebted to said ~~MECHANICS BUILDING AND LOAN ASSOCIATION~~ in the sum of Eighteen Hundred and Eighty Dollars,  
Dollars, money loaned this day, with interest thereon from this date to the rate of eight  
per cent. per annum, payable weekly,

the payment whereof the said party of the first part is anxious to secure.

Now, therefore, in consideration of the premises and in further consideration of one dollar to him in hand paid the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, the said party of the first part has granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said party of the second part all that certain piece, parcel and lot of land lying in Greenville County, in the State aforesaid, as follows, to-wit:

All that piece, parcel and lot of land situate in the City of Greenville, County and State aforesaid, on the South side of John Street, described as follows:

Beginning at the northeast corner of the Moore property and running thence along John Street in an easterly direction 38 1/6 feet to a point; thence in a southerly direction in a line parallel to Moores line 100 feet to a point; thence in a westerly direction in a line parallel with John Street 38 1/6 feet to a point in line of Moores property; thence along Moores line in a northerly direction 100 feet to the point of beginning on John Street.

The above described lot is the eastern half of the lot which has a frontage on John Street of 77 feet and 8 inches and a depth of 100 feet, and is a part of the lot formerly owned by St. P. Congers. This conveyance is on condition that there shall be left open a right-of-way of ingress and egress five feet wide, running back 100 feet, from John Street on the Eastern side of this lot and a like condition is made for a strip five feet in width and 100 feet in depth at the Western side of the Eastern half of said lot, so that the grantee herin her successors, heirs and assigns shall have the joint use of a ten foot driveway 100 feet in depth with the adjoining owner of the Eastern half of said lot.
