

THE STATE OF SOUTH CAROLINA,

TO ALL WHOM THESE PRESENTS MAY CONCERN:

Lillie Campbell of Greenville, in the County of Greenville, and the State of South Carolina, send Greeting:

WHEREAS, I, the said Lillie Campbell, in and by my certain note or obligation, bearing date the 3rd day of January 1929

indebted unto The Carolina Loan and Trust Company, of the City and County of Greenville, in said State (a body corporate, duly incorporated under the laws of such State), in the sum of twenty-three hundred (\$2,300.00) Dollars,

with interest thereon at the rate of eight per centum per annum, payable monthly, from the 3rd day of January A. D. 1929 according to the provisions of the Charter, By-Laws, Rules and Regulations of the said Company, in manner and form following, that is to say, that

the said Lillie Campbell shall pay or cause to be paid to the said Company, or its certain attorneys, successors or assigns, at Greenville City aforesaid, monthly, on the 20th or before the end of the month of January 1929, and on the 20th or before the end of each month thereafter for twenty successive months, the sum of thirty-six and 43/100 (\$36.43) Dollars,

( \$23.00 Dollars, being the regular monthly installment payable on the twenty-three Shares of Stock, and Thirteen @ \$1.00 \$13.00 Dollars, being the monthly interest on the advance or loan) until there have been paid twenty monthly payments, and shall for the next twenty months pay the sum of thirty-three and 73/100 (\$33.73) Dollars,

( \$23.00 Dollars, being the regular monthly payment on said stock and Ten @ 73/100 \$7.30 Dollars, being the monthly interest on balance due); for the next twenty months the sum of thirty-one and 06/100 (\$31.06) Dollars,

( \$23.00 Dollars, being the regular monthly payment on said stock and eight @ 09/100 \$0.72 Dollars, being the monthly interest on balance due); for the next twenty months pay the sum of twenty-eight and 37/100 (\$28.37) Dollars,

( \$23.00 Dollars, being the regular monthly payment on said shares of stock and two @ 09/100 \$0.18 Dollars, being the monthly interest on balance due.); for the next twenty months pay the sum of twenty-five and 68/100 (\$25.68) Dollars,

( \$23.00 Dollars, being the regular monthly payment on said shares of stock and two @ 09/100 \$0.18 Dollars, being the monthly interest on balance due.) Each of the above payments to be made on the 20th or before the last day of each month, and shall thereafter surrender to the Company the said 23 shares of stock and the certificate thereon, the amount at such time paid shares by me to be credited as a payment upon the advance or loan made me, the said Lillie Campbell

and shall pay or cause to be paid all fines which may be duly imposed upon, or charged against me, the said Lillie Campbell in accordance with the Charter, By-Laws, Rules and Regulations, as in and by the said note or obligation, and the condition thereunder written, reference being thereunto had will more fully appear.

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That I, the said Lillie Campbell, in consideration of the said debt and sum of money as aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said The Carolina Loan and Trust Company, according to the terms of said note or obligation, and also in consideration of the further sum of Five Dollars to me

the said Lillie Campbell, in hand well and truly paid by the said The Carolina Loan and Trust Company, at and before the sealing and delivery of these Presents, (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents, do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said The Carolina Loan and Trust Company, all that tract or parcel of land, situated in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, and described as follows:

In the town of West Greenville, situate at the northwest intersection of Queen Street and Perry Avenue, and running thence along Queen Street North 137 feet to an iron pin, thence West 50 feet to an iron pin, thence South 137 feet back to a point on Perry Avenue, thence along Perry Avenue East 50 feet to the beginning corner. The same being known as no 702 of Perry Avenue and is the same lot conveyed to me Lillie Campbell by John A. Boushillon by deed dated December 31, 1928, recorded in Volume 148 Page 213 R.M.C. office for Greenville County.

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
