WHEREAS, *J. E. Hall*, the said *J. E. Hall*  
in and by *my* certain *promissory* note, in writing, of  
even date with these presents, *am* well and truly indebted to  
*Jas. M. Richardson, as Trustee,*  
in the full and just sum of *Four Hundred Sixty-eight (\$468.00)*  
Dollars, to be paid *March 1st, 1929*

with interest thereon, from *12th day of March 1929* at the rate of *8* per cent. per annum to be  
computed and paid *annually*  
until paid in full, interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or  
interest be in any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may  
thereon and foreclose this mortgage, said note further providing for an attorney's fee of

*8* per cent. besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be  
added to the amount due on said note, to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part  
thereof, be collected by an attorney or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by the said note, reference  
being thereunto had as will more fully appear.

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, that *J. E. Hall*  
in consideration of the debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said  
*Jas. M. Richardson, as Trustee,*  
according to the terms of the said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars, to *me*, the said

*J. E. Hall* in hand well and truly paid by the said  
*Jas. M. Richardson, as Trustee,*  
at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents do grant, bar-  
gain, sell and release unto the said *Jas. M. Richardson, as Trustee, his*

successors and assigns:

*All that certain lot of land in Greenville  
County, State of South Carolina, about three  
miles from Greenville County Court House,  
near the Union Bleachery, in subdivision  
known as McCullough Heights, and being  
known and designated as lot no 37 on said  
subdivision, according to plat of same re-  
corded in the office of R. M. C. for Greenville  
County in Plat Book E. at page 95, and  
having the following metes and bounds:  
Beginning at a point on Verdum  
Avenue, joint corner with lots nos 35  
and 37, and running thence with line  
of lot no 35 N. 45-26 E. 157.6 feet to iron pin;  
thence N. 44-20 W. 60 ft to point on 10-foot  
alley; thence with said alley S. 45-26 W.  
157.6 feet to iron pin on Verdum Avenue;  
thence S. 44-20 E. 60 feet to the beginning  
corner. This being the same lot conveyed  
to me by Jas. M. Richardson, as Trustee, by  
deed dated Jan 19, 1929, yet to be recorded.*
