All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Highland Township, Greenville County, S.C., on the south side of the Lewis Bridge Road and being all of tract No. 5 according to plat of S. W. B. F. and J. J. Reese property made by H. S. Grothmann, Surveyor, on December 2, 1928, and having the following metes and bounds: Beginning at an iron pin in the center of Lewis Bridge Road, corner of tracts numbers one and five, and running thence along center of said road S. 76-45<sup>W.</sup> 100' to bend in said road; thence along center of said road S. 68<sup>W.</sup> 300' to bend in road; thence along center of road S. 57<sup>W.</sup> 100' to another bend in road; thence S. 48<sup>W.</sup> 500' to another bend in road; thence S. 51<sup>W.</sup> 100' feet to a slight bend in road, corner of tracts Nos. one and two; thence S. 72<sup>W.</sup> 100' to bend in road; thence along center of said road S. 84-15<sup>W.</sup> 95' to point in road on old Lewis Cemetery line; thence along said cemetery line S. 32<sup>E.</sup> 122' to center of old road on (ignacious) Few line; thence N. 62-50<sup>E.</sup> 63' to iron pin on Few line; thence S. 85-51<sup>E.</sup> 1274' to an iron pin on Ephriam Few branch; thence N. 17-32<sup>W.</sup> 845.5' along A. B. Cannon line to an iron pin in the center of Lewis Bridge Road, this being the beginning corner and being all of tract #5 according to said plat of land and containing fifteen (15) acres, more or less, and being the same tract conveyed by Minnie A.
