 Ward Five of the City of Greenville on the south
 side of Arlington Avenue (formerly Garlington
 Street) and an extension of Mallard Street, and
 being known as Lot no 20, as shown on a plat
 of the Silas McBee Avenue, said plat being
 made by H. Olin Jones, Engineer, February 1913
 and recorded in Volume 6, at page 62, in the
 R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, the said lot
 having the following metes and bounds:

Beginning at an iron pin at the southwest corner of Arlington Avenue and Mallard Street, and running thence along the line of Arlington Avenue N. 71-41 W. 63.8 feet to the corner of lot no 8 as shown on said plat; thence along the east line of lot no 8, S 18-38 W. 150 feet to an iron pin in the northern line of lot no 10, thence S 71-41 E. 63.8 feet to an iron pin in the line of Mallard Street, thence along Mallard Street N. 18-39 E. 150 feet to the beginning corner, and being the same lot conveyed to J.
