SEND GREETING:

WHEREAS, we, the said St. R. Neely and R. L. Prince
in and by our certain promissory note, in writing, of
even date with these presents, are

Peoples National Bank, as Trustee for Marshall Fund
in the full and just sum of Six Thousand (\$6,000.00)
Dollars, to be paid one year after date,

with interest thereon, from date paid full and true
computed and paid semi-annually at

until paid in full all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage, and note further providing for an attorney's fee of ~~ten~~ per cent

besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to the amount due on said note, to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part thereof, be collected by an attorney or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured by this mortgage), as in and by the said note, reference being thereunto had, as will more fully appear.

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That we, the said St. R. Neely and R. L. Prince

in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said

Peoples National Bank, as aforesaid,
according to the terms of the said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars, to us, the said

St. R. Neely and R. L. Prince
in hand well and truly paid by the said

Peoples National Bank, as Trustee for Marshall Fund
at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Peoples National Bank, as Trustee for
Marshall Fund.

The following described lot of land owned by said St. R. Neely and R. L. Prince, jointly, each of said parties owning a one-half interest in said lot;

All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, about one and a half miles northwest of Greenville Court House, S.C., having the following metes and bounds: Beginning on the east side of Buncombe Road at the intersection of said road and Neely Avenue and running thence along the north side of Neely Avenue (about, S. 76 $\frac{1}{2}$ E. 106 feet to an iron pin; thence north westerly parallel with Buncombe Road 100 feet, more or less, to an iron pin in line of the H. J. McAlister lot (said corner being 106 feet from the East side of Buncombe Road,) thence along McAlister line (about, N. 84 $\frac{1}{2}$ E. 106 feet to an iron pin on Buncombe Road, thence along Buncombe Road S. 11 $\frac{3}{4}$ W. 81 feet more or less, to the beginning corner. This land is bounded on the North by McAlister lot, on the East by Andrew B. Neely lot, on the South by Neely Avenue, and on the West by the Buncombe Road, being the same lot of land conveyed to St. R. Neely by Andrew B. Neely by deed dated March 3, 1925, recorded in office of R. M. Co. for Greenville County in Deed Book 97 at page 95, and in which R. L. Prince acquired a one-half interest by deed from J. L. Styles dated November 12, 1929, recorded in said office in Deed Book 134 at page 481.

Also: all that piece parcel or lot of land in Greenville County, State of South Carolina, near the corporate limits of the City of Greenville, about two miles from the Court House on the west side of the Buncombe Road and known as Lot no 207 on plat of land conveyed to Elzad McCrary by S. M. Snider, said plat being made by St. A. Hudson, and having the following metes and bounds: Beginning at an iron pin in Buncombe Road 208 feet from the south side of Master Street and running thence S. 13 $\frac{1}{2}$ E. Sixty-six feet to an iron pin in said road, thence westerly with line of lot no 206 two hundred and four feet to a stake, thence first line of lot no 213 sixty-six feet to a stake, thence easterly with line of lot no 208 two hundred and four feet to the beginning corner. This lot is bounded by said St. R. Neely and was conveyed to him by Elzad McCrary, by deed dated April 26, 1905, recorded in office of R. M. Co. for Greenville County in Deed Book 134 at page 481.
