all that tract or lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina.

Near the Easley Bridge Road, on Welcome Road, containing 3.90 acres, more or less, and known as tract no. 92 on plat of F. R. Young property made by Dalton & Neves April 1928, and having the following metes and bounds: Beginning at an iron pipe on Welcome Road, 535.8 feet south of the intersection of Springfield Street and Welcome Road, corner of tract no. 93, and running thence N. 1-42 W. 273 feet to poplar tree; thence N. 18-42 E. 127 feet to iron pipe; thence N. 25-00 W. 212 feet to iron pipe on Springfield Street; thence along said street N. 60-00 E. 254.4 feet to iron pipe, corner of tract no. 91 now owned by W. P. Lark; thence S. 30-55 E. 285.8 feet to iron pipe; thence S. 18-55 W. 641.2 feet to iron pipe on Welcome Road; thence along said road N. 49-25 W. 53.8 feet to iron pipe, thence still along said road N. 30-52 W. 120.6 feet to beginning.

Also that other tract of land in township, county and State aforesaid, on Welcome Road, containing 3.18 acres, more or less, being part of tract no. 94, on plat above referred to, having the following metes and bounds: Beginning at an iron pipe on the west side of Welcome Road, at a point where the branch crosses the road; thence S. 2-00 E (along Branch Part of way) 580 feet to iron pipe; thence N. 74-55 E. 540.1 feet to iron pipe; thence N. 19-35 E. 47.6 feet to iron pipe on Welcome Road; thence along the Welcome Road as follows: N. 67-49 W. 212.2 feet to iron pipe; N. 57-16 W. 184 feet to iron pipe; N. 49-25 W. 214.5 feet to iron pipe; N. 30-52 W. 88.7 feet to the beginning corner.
