with interest thereon, from date until paid at the rate of 8 per cent. per annum to be computed and paid semi-annually.

until paid in full all interest not paid which is to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage, said note further providing for an attorney's fee.

~~I, Nellie Grace Brown, do hereby give and grant unto Tom Goldsmith, Trustee, his successors and assigns, the sum of Nine hundred, Sixty Seven & 28/100 Dollars, besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to the amount due on the said note, to be collectible as a part thereof; if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part thereof, be collected by an attorney, or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by the said note, reference being thereunto had, as will more fully appear.~~

Tom Goldsmith, Trustee, at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold, and released and by these Presents do grant, bar-

gain, sell and release unto the said, Tom Goldsmith, Trustee, his successors and assigns,

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in the County and State aforesaid, about 2½ miles north of the city of Greenville in the section known as Mountain View, and being designated as lot no. 62 in Block B of Plat dated February 1910, made by H. A. Adams and recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in "Plat Book D" pages 396 and 397 and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

Beginning at a stake on the east side of Bailey Street, joint corners lots 62 and 63 S. 89 ½ E. 81 45 feet to a ten foot post, thence with said alley in 11 ½ ft. 50 feet to a stake, joint corner lots nos. 62 and 61, thence with the line of lot no. 61 N. 89 ½ ft. 14.5 feet to a stake on Bailey Street, thence with Bailey Street S. 11 ½ E. 50 feet to the beginning corner and being the same lot of land conveyed to me by Annie L. Martin by deed dated 31st October 1921, and in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Vol. 75 at page 19.
