SEND GREETING:

WHEREAS, *I, Geo H Brown*, the said *Geo H Brown*, in and by *my* certain promissory note, in writing, of even date with these presents, *are* well and truly indebted to *Tommie C. Putman* in the full and just sum of *Twenty Two hundred and fifty* Dollars, to be paid *One year after date*.

with interest thereon, from *date* at the rate of *8 1/2 %* per cent. per annum to be computed and paid *semi-annually* until paid in full all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage, said note further providing for an attorney's fee of *10 00*.

besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to the amount due on the said note, to be collectible as a part thereof; in the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or the said debt or any part thereof, be collected by an attorney or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by the said note, reference being thereto had, as will more fully appear.

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That *Geo H Brown*, in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said *Tommie C. Putman*, according to the terms of the said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars, to *Geo H Brown*, in hand well and truly paid by the said *Tommie C. Putman*,

at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold, and released and by these Presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said *Tommie C. Putman*, her heirs and assigns, all that lot of land situate in the State and County aforesaid, near the Laurens Road, and in the subdivision of Eastover, designated as lot 72, one half recorded in plat Book 3, Page 2, and having a frontage of 60 feet on Peden Street, and running back in parallel lines a distance 150 feet, and being the same tract of land conveyed, to me this 14th day of December 1929, by *Tommy C. Putman*, and being a purchase of money mortgage.
