SEND GREETING:

WHEREAS, we, the said E. D. Fry and Effie Fry, in and by our certain promissory note, in writing, of even date with these presents, are well and truly indebted to Guy B. Foster,

in the full and just sum of One Thousand Sixty-six and no/100 (\$1067.00) Dollars, to be paid Two years from date

with interest thereon, from date, at the rate of 8 per cent. per annum to be computed and paid semi-annually, until paid in full all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note, to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage, said note further providing for an attorney's fee of Ten per cent., besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to the amount due on the said note, to be collectible as a part thereof; if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part thereof, be collected by an attorney or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by the said note, reference being thereunto had, as will more fully appear.

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That we, the said E. D. Fry and Effie Fry, in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment hereof, to the end Guy B. Foster, according to the terms of the said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars, to the said E. D. Fry and Effie Fry, in hand well and truly paid by the said Guy B. Foster,

at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold, and released and by these Presents do grant, barter, sell and release unto the said Guy B. Foster,

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land in the City of Greenville, the same being a portion of the Stoneyland Company, and being known and designated as lot no 8 of Section A, on the west side of Vannoy St., according to a plat recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book 'A' at pages 337 to 345, and having the following metes and bounds, to wit,

Commencing at a stake on the west side of Vannoy Street and running thence N. 71-50 E. 192 feet 7 inches to a stake, thence S. 20-19 E. 55 feet to a stake, thence S. 71-50 E. 192 feet 7 inches to a stake on Vannoy Street, thence with Vannoy Street N. 20-19 E. 55 feet to the beginning corner.

This is the same land conveyed to us by J. M. Wells, deed dated May 7, 1928, and recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Vol 143, page 238.
