MORTGAGE OF REAL ESTATE

TO ALL WHOM THESE PRESENTS MAY CONCERN:

SEND GREETING:

WHEREAS, Erie D. Rector, the said Erie D. Rector,
 in and by 2000 certain promissory note in writing, of
 even date with these presents, to C. L. White, well and truly indebted to
 in the full and just sum of Twenty Five hundred
 Dollars, to be paid one year from date

with interest thereon, from date until paid at the rate of 8 1/2 per cent. per annum to be
 computed and paid semi-annually in advance until paid in full all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage, said note further providing for an attorney's fee of 10% of the amount due and unpaid, besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to the amount due on the said note, to be collectible as a part thereof; if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part thereof, be collected by an attorney or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by the said note, reference being thereto had, as will more fully appear.

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That Erie D. Rector, the said Erie D. Rector,

in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said C. L. White,

according to the terms of the said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars, to me, the said Erie D. Rector,

in hand well and truly paid by the said Erie D. Rector,

at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold, and released and by these Presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said C. L. White

C. L. White, his heirs and assigns # 1463
all of the certain pieces of parcels or tracts of land situati, lying and being in Greenville Township, State and County aforesaid, on the Laurens Road, described as follows:
First Tract: Beginning at a pin on the Laurens Road, at Glensie corner, and running thence S. 33° 8' 6.60 chs. to an iron pin, thence S. 56° 1/2' E. 1.51 chs. to an iron pin, thence N. 56° 1/2' E. 1.51 chs. to the beginning corner, containing one acre, more or less, and being about one quarter of a mile from the corporate limits of the city of Greenville.
Second Tract: Beginning at a stake on the Laurens Road at corner of above mentioned tract and running thence N. 32° 34' E. 9.60 chs. to a stone, thence S. 65° 1/2' E. 21.00 chs. with C. & S. C. Railway 2.60 chs. to an iron pin, thence S. 32° 34' E. 11.35 chs. to an iron pin, thence with the Laurens Road S. 56° E. 2.60 chs. to the beginning corner, containing three acres, more or less, lying the same tract of land conveyed to me, the Erie D. Rector, by J. F. Scott, Probate Judge for said County, by her deed dated July 1922, and recorded, in the R. M. C. office for said County in Vol. 85, page 44.

Excluded from this Mortgage however is a certain tract of land, containing 1.76 acres, more or less, fully described in a deed, from me to B. A. Thomas, dated May 20, 1927, said deed, recorded, in R. M. C. office for said County in Vol. 124 page 330, to which deed reference is hereby made.
