WHEREAS, *I*, the said *C. Lila McRae*, in and by *my* certain *promise* *say* even date with these presents, *am* *well and truly indebted to* *B. E. Pritchette* in the full and just sum of *one thousand (\$1,000.00)* Dollars, to be paid *one year after date*.

with interest thereon, from *date* at the rate of *8 1/2* per cent. per annum to be computed and paid *semi-annually* # 6173

until paid in full. Interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage, said note further providing for an attorney's fee of *ten dollars exact*

besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to the amount due on the said note to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part thereof, be collected by an attorney or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by the said note, reference being thereto had, as will more fully appear.

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, THAT the said *C. Lila McRae*, in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said *B. E. Pritchette*,

according to the terms of the said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars, to the said *C. Lila McRae*, in hand well and truly paid by the said *B. E. Pritchette*,

at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold, and released and by these Presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said *B. E. Pritchette*, his heirs and assigns,

all that certain piece or parcel of land in the City of Greenville, bounded as follows: and having according to the plat made by J. B. Adams January 1910; Beginning at a stake and Addison Avenue corner of lot No. 10 and running thence along Addison Avenue, 116-24-16-24-88 feet low water stake corner of lot No. 12; thence S. 76-34-34 W. 180 feet to a stake corner of lot No. 10; thence N. 76-34-34 E. 180 feet to the beginning corner or side being the corner of lot No. 11, said lot described as,

"his being a portion of a tract of land in the name of B. E. Pritchette, Esq., deceased, Soc. of Friends, dated April 1, 1928."
