Allison property on the south side of Burrowside Street and running thence along said street in a northwesterly direction 110 feet to a valley parallel with Echols Street, the end of said valley in a southerly direction 140 feet to said east side alley; thence in a westerly direction 110 feet parallel with Burrowside Street to the W. A. Allison property; thence along line of Allison property 140 feet to the beginning of carnes.
