Dollars, to be paid *One year from date*

with interest thereon, from *date* at the rate of *8* per cent. per annum to be
computed and paid *annually*

until paid in full all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal
or interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note..... to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may
sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage, said note further providing for an attorney's fee of *ten per cent.*

besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be
added to the amount due on the said note....., to be collectible as a part thereof; if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part
thereof, be collected by an attorney or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by the said note....., reference being
thereunto had, as will more fully appear.

in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said *S. M. Jones*

according to the terms of the said note....., and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars, to *me*, the said

in hand well and truly paid by the said *S. M. Jones*

at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold, and released and by these Presents do grant, bar-
gain, sell and release unto the said *S. M. Jones, his heirs and assigns*

forever,

All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, and having the following lines, streets and
bounds according to plat of "Cast Park" Bayee addition,
made by W. A. Adams, Surveyor, dated March 31, 1910,
and recorded in the R. M. B. office for said County
and State in Plat Book "A" at page 283; to wit: Beginning
at an iron pin on Bayee Spring Street, joint
corner of Lots #63 and #64 and running thence in
a N.W. direction along line of said lots, 142 feet and 10
inches to iron pin on line of lot #58; thence S.W. direc-
tion along line of lot #58, 60 feet to iron pin, joint
corner of lots #57-58-65-64; thence in a S.E. direction
along line of lots #64 and #65, 107 feet to Bayee Spring
Street; thence along said street, 56 feet to an iron
pin, thence along said street, 10 feet and 10 inches
to the beginning; being known and designated
as lot Number Sixty Four (Lot #64) in "Black Hill" another
plat hereinabove named; this being the same lot
of land conveyed to J. A. Campbell by deed dated
July 1, 1929 and recorded in Vol. 148, page 58, and same lot of land conveyed
