until paid in full all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage, said note further providing for an attorney's fee of 5 per cent.

besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to the amount due on the said note, to be collectible as a part thereof; if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part thereof, be collected by an attorney or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by the said note, reference being thereto had, as will more fully appear.

all that piece or parcel of lot of land in Greenville County, Greenville Township, State of South Carolina about three miles north of the City of Greenville, and being lot no. 89 of a tract of Land known as the Colonial Company Tract and having the following metes and bounds:

Beginning on the West side of Donnybrook Avenue at iron Pin, joint corner lots 89 and 90; thence with joint lots 89 and 90 N. 51-44 W. 201.8 feet to iron pin, joint corner of lots 89, 90, 89A and 90A; thence with joint line of lots 89 and 89A, S. 46-50 W. 50 feet to iron Pin, joint corner lots 89, 88, 89A and 88A; thence with joint lines of lots 89 and 88, S. 44-02 E. 200 feet to iron Pin, joint corner lots 89 and 88 and also being on the West side of Donnybrook Avenue thence with West side of Donnybrook Avenue N. 46-50 E. 77 feet to iron Pin and being also the Beginning corner, as shown on plat recorded in plat Book G. page 112.
