even date with these presents, am well and truly indebted to

J. Rolfe Babb, in the full and just sum of Two Thousand (\$2,000.00)

Dollars, to be paid November 1st, 1930, and

with interest thereon, from date hereof, paid quarterly, at the rate of per cent. per annum to be

computed and paid annually until paid in full all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal

or interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage, said note further providing for an attorney's fee of ten percent, besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be

added to the amount due on the said date, to be collectible as a part thereof; if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part thereof, be collected by an attorney or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by the said note, reference being thereto had, as will more fully appear.

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That I, the said Mrs. Sue Jones, in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said J. Rolfe Babb

according to the terms of the said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars, to me, the said

Mrs. Sue Jones, in hand well and truly paid by the said J. Rolfe Babb.

at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold, and released and by these Presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said J. Rolfe Babb,

the said J. Rolfe Babb, all that lot or parcel of land lying, being and situate on Branch Walters of Durbin Creek in Fairview Township, County of Greenville State of South Carolina, bounded by dalls of Jake Watson, W. M. Chamblee, J. S. L. Hodges, and others, Commencing at a stone, S. 35 $\frac{1}{4}$ E. 9.40 to a corner; thence S. 37 W. 21.00 to a stone; thence S. 54 W. 24.00 to a stone; thence S. $\frac{1}{2}$ W. 6.40 to a stone; thence S. 20 W. 10.20 to a stone; thence S. 24 $\frac{1}{2}$ W. 5.90 to a stone; thence S. 33 W. 18.00 to a stone; thence N. 49 $\frac{1}{2}$ W. 9.00 to center of creek; thence down said creek to where Branch enters in; thence up said Branch to a stone, J. D. Jones' Corner; thence N. 33 E. 21.00 to center of Road; thence N. 32 E. 9.30 to a pin in Road; thence N. 17 $\frac{1}{4}$ E. 5.00 to a stone; thence S. 79 E. 10.00 to a stone; thence N. 37 E. 13.77 to Beginning corner, containing 75 acres more or less.
