 computed and paid ^{quarterly} until paid in full all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal
 or interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may
 sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage, said note further providing for an attorney's fee of ^{less} per cent
 besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to the amount due on the said note, to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part
 thereof, be collected by an attorney or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by the said note, reference being
 thereto had, as will more fully appear.

 side of the Faris Road, and being a part of that certain lot
 Conveyed to J. B. League by W. H. Benson, by his deed dated May
 1, 1924 and recorded in the R. M. C. office for Greenville County in
 said lot Conveyed hereby, being more particularly described as
 follows: Beginning at the point corner of lots 7 and 9, according
 to a division of the lots of L. W. Faris property made by
 J. C. Daffton, C. E. J. B. League, and running thence N. 68-47 E.
