MORTGAGE OF REAL ESTATE

I, Flora E. Templeton

TO ALL WHOM THESE PRESENTS MAY CONCERN:

SEND GREETING:

WHEREAS, I, the said Flora E. Templeton, in and by a certain promissory note in writing, of even date with these presents, (d. t.) well and truly indebted to

South Carolina Savings Bank, in the full and just sum of Six hundred Ninety two and 18/100 Dollars, to be paid December 1, 1930.

with interest thereon from the date of this note, at the rate of 8 per cent. per annum to be computed and paid.

until paid in full all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage, said note further providing for an attorney's fee of 100.00.

besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to the amount due on the said note, to be collectible as a part thereof; if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part thereof, be collected by an attorney or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by the said note, reference being thereto had, as will more fully appear.

All that lot or parcel of land lying and situated near the town of Fountain Inn, County and State aforesaid, Containing eighteen and one fourth acres, more or less, and hath the following metes and bounds: wit: Bounded by lands of B. J. Cox Estate west and myself, commencing at a stone, said Cox Estate corner, running thence S 8 1/4 E. 8.35 to a stone on branch, thence S. 63 3/4 E. 10.00 to a stone; thence S 8 1/4 E. 2.50 to a stone; thence S. 28 3/4 E. 13.10 to stone on road; thence N. 1 1/2 E. 22.84 to a stone; thence N. 80 3/4 E. 9.56 to a small black gum; thence S. 30 E. 8.40 to a stone; thence S. 78 1/4 W. 11.77 to beginning corner.
