SEND GREETING:

WHEREAS, *R. G. Hodgeon*, the said *R. G. Hodgeon*
 in and by *May* certain *Real Estate* note in writing, of
 even date with these presents, *one* well and truly indebted to

Hudson Lumber Co. (*Paid in Full*)
 in the full and just sum of *Fifteen hundred Ninety-two \$1522.00 plus expenses*
 Dollars, to be paid *Six months after date*. *Feb 1st 1930*

with interest thereon, from *date* (*Feb 1st 1930*) at the rate of *8* per cent. per annum to be
 computed and paid *annually*.

until paid in full all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal
 or interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may
 sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage, said note further providing for an attorney's fee of *transfer costs*.

besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to the amount due on the said note, to be collectible as a part thereof; if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part
 thereof, be collected by an attorney or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage) as in and by the said note, reference being
 thereto had, as will more fully appear.

 gain, sell and release unto the said *Hudson Lumber Co.*

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, situated and
 being in the State and County aforesaid in the town of Greenville
 and being known and designated as lot number 16 starting at an
 iron pin at the corner of Spring Street and Westmoreland Avenue,
 running thence with Westmoreland Avenue 48.7 feet to an iron pin
 at the corner of lots number 15 and 16; thence north 125 feet to
 corner of lots number 17 and 18; thence west 78 feet to corner of
 lots number 16 and 17 on Spring Street; thence running with Spring
 Street 125 feet to beginning corner. Original plat of this land being
