Personally appeared before me A. D. L. Barksdale, who on oath says:

At the time M. A. Meadors executed the \$1200.00 mortgage to Mrs. Ola B. Gilreath she had only \$1,000.00 for investment, and I was handling the loan for Mrs. Gilreath and Mr. Meadors. I knew that Mr. Meadors needed \$1200.00, and suggested to Mrs. Gilreath that the mortgage be made to her for this amount and that Meadors give her two notes, one for \$1,000.00 and one for \$200.00 and I would put up the \$200.00 along with her \$1,000.00 and she could assign the \$200.00 note to me without recourse.

The matter was handled in this way, the mortgage referred to being recorded in Mortgage Book 134, page 57, R. M. C. Office for Greenville County. On November 3, 1928, M. A. Meadors paid me the principal and interest then due on the \$200.00 note, but I did not surrender the note for the reason that I had lost or misplaced it, and I have never been able to find it, although I have made diligent search for it. I never negotiated the \$200.00 note in any way whatever, and at the time it was delivered by Mrs. Gilreath to me, as well as at the time when Mr. Meadors paid it off to me, the \$200.00 note belonged to me.
