Whereas, the said Edith L. Gleason, in and by certain note in writing, of even date with these presents, am well and truly indebted to Greenville Townspeople's College in the full and just sum of \$1,000.00, to be paid June 13, of each year, dated from the date secured by the said note, in full, and before signing of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released and by the Presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Greenville Townspeople's College, all that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in Greenville Township, Greenville County, State aforesaid, near the Augusta Road School Site, one-half acre of land being in Adeline and being known and designated as Lot no 54 of the C. B. Masters subdivision, as shown on a plat of record in Plat Book I, page 102, and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to wit:

Beginning at an iron pipe at the Southeastern intersection of Highland Drive and Tennessee Avenue and running thence along Tennessee Avenue S. 45-50 E. 192.1 feet to an iron pipe; thence S. 41-10 E. 71 feet to an iron pipe, joint corner of lots 54 and 55; thence along the line of lot no 55 N. 48-50 E. 192.1 feet to an iron pipe on Highland Drive; thence along Highland Drive N. 41-10 E. 71 feet to the point of beginning. This being the same lot of land conveyed to me by the American Bank and Trust Company, Trustee, by deed dated July 15, 1924, and recorded in the R. M. O. Office for Greenville County in Volume 101, at page 75.
