Whereas, Wm. Ashby Stewart and Daisy S. Stewart, SEND GREETING:  
 in and by me certain promissory note in writing, of even date with these presents, and  
 well and truly indebted to Clester E. Furman  
 in the full and just sum of Twenty five hundred fifty and 50/100 dollars  
 to be paid as follows:

Twenty (\$20.00) dollars on the 1st day of each and every month  
 beginning October 1, 1930 and ending September 1, 1931; Twenty-five  
(\$25.00) dollars on the 1st day of each and every month beginning October 1,  
1931 and ending September 1, 1935; and the balance, then remaining  
 with interest thereon from September 1, 1935 date.

at the rate of 7 1/2% per centum per annum, to be computed and paid Semi-annually

until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear  
interest at same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or interest be  
any time past due and unpaid, the whole amount evidenced by said note to  
become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; and in case said note, after its maturity, should  
be placed in the hands of an attorney for suit or collection, or if before its maturity it should be deemed by the holder thereof necessary for the protection  
of his interests to place and the holder should place the said note or this mortgage in the hands of an attorney for any legal proceedings, then and in either  
of said cases the mortgagor promises to pay all costs and expenses including 10 per cent of the indebtedness as attorneys' fees, this to be added to the mort-  
gage indebtedness, and to be secured under this mortgage as a part of said debt.

 edged, have granted, bargained, sold and released and by the Presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Clester E. Furman

All that certain lot or parcel of land situate, lying  
 and being in the County of Greenville, State of South  
 Carolina, and in the Second Ward of the City of Greenville  
 and having the following lines and boundaries, to wit:-

Beginning at a stake at Southwest corner of  
 Angle and Maryland Streets, and running thence  
 with said Street, S. 77° W. 145.7 feet to stake; thence  
 S. 9.10 E. 56.6 feet to stake; thence N. 77° E. 149.4 feet  
 to stake on Maryland Street; thence with Maryland  
 Street 56.6 feet to the point of beginning.
