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until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid, the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; and in case said note, after its maturity, should be placed in the hands of an attorney for suit or collection, or if before its maturity it should be deemed by the holder thereof necessary for the protection of his interests to place and the holder should place the said note or this mortgage in the hands of an attorney for any legal proceedings, then and in either of said cases the mortgagor promises to pay all costs and expenses including 10 per cent. of the indebtedness as attorneys' fees, this to be added to the mortgage indebtedness, and to be secured under this mortgage as a part of said debt.

edged, have granted, bargained, sold and released and by the Presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Alexander Fiellay
all that piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in Rock Springs Township
seven miles from the City of Greenville on both sides of the P. & N. Railway and National Highway
beginning at a B. Black's N. M. Post office and the Southern Railway being the first
stone and having the following bounds: -
Beginning at a iron pin on the Southern Railway; thence with said
iron pin 87 48' E. 8. 68 to iron pipe; thence N. 14 1/2 E. 28. 50 to a stone; thence N. 63 W.
30 to stone on line of A. B. Black's land; thence S. 19 1/2 W. 18. 19 to an iron pin; thence
5 1/2 W. 15. 03 to the beginning, containing 30 acres, more or less.
Also, all that piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in
Rock Springs Township on the P. & N. Railway right-of-way and having the
following metes and bounds, according to a plat made by W. Adams
Surveyor, April 9, 1914, to wit:
