All that parcel, piece or lot of land with the buildings and improvements thereon, situate, lying and being in the City of Greenville, County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, on the South side of Croft Street and being known as a portion of Lot No. 5 on plat of property of E. O. Stone made by Dalton & Peacock, Engineers, July 1, 1925, and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, courses and distances, to-wit:

Beginning at an iron pin on the South side of Croft Street, which iron pin is 110 feet West of the Southwest corner of the intersection of Croft and Holmes Streets, and running thence S. 55-55 W. 150 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 84-25 W. 21 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 5-25 W. 50 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 84-25 W. 21 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 1-15 E. 200 feet to an iron pin on the South side of Croft Street; thence with the South side of Croft Street S. 84-25 E. 60 feet to the point of beginning; being the same lot conveyed to the mortgagor herein by deed of E.
