TO WHOM ALL THESE PRESENTS MAY CONCERN:

I, Charles E. Braga, SEND GREETING:  
 Whereas, I, the said Charles E. Braga

in and by my certain promissory note in writing, of even date with these presents, well and truly indebted to Utopian Developing Company, in the full and just sum of One Hundred Fifty Dollars, to be paid three (3) years after date, with the privilege of anticipating its payment at any time,

March 31, 1931, 6% [# 2966]  
 with interest thereon from the date of rendering

at the rate of 6 per centum per annum, to be computed and paid semi-annually,

until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid, the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; and in case said note, after its maturity, should be placed in the hands of an attorney for suit or collection, or if before its maturity it should be deemed by the holder thereof necessary for the protection of his interests to place and the holder should place the said note or this mortgage in the hands of an attorney for any legal proceedings, then and in either of said cases the mortgagor promises to pay all costs and expenses including 10 per cent. of the indebtedness as attorneys' fees, this to be added to the mortgage indebtedness, and to be secured under this mortgage as a part of said debt.

NOW KNOW ALL MEN, that I, the said Charles E. Braga,

in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the Utopian Developing Company according to the terms of the said note, and also in consideration to the further sum of Three Dollars, to me,

 in hand well and truly paid by the said Utopian Developing Company at and before signing of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released and by the presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said

Utopian Developing Company:

All that certain piece or lot of land situated, lying and being in Greenville County, State of South Carolina, near the city of Greenville, being known and designated as Lot No. 2 of Block 1, in the subdivision known as "Hatchgate," of the property of Utopian Developing Company, and having, according to the revised plat thereof, recorded in the Office of the Greenville County, in Plat Book 1, at page 135-6; the following lines and boundaries and distances, to-wit:

Beginning at an iron pin on the west side of Arcadia Drive, the joint corner of Lots Nos. 1 and 2, and running thence with the joint line as said lots, S. 64-35 W. 109.9 feet to an iron pin in line of lot No. 17; thence with line of lot No. 17, N. 16-34 W. 15 feet to an iron pin; thence along the rear line of lot No. 17, S. 84-00 W. 88.2 feet to an iron pin in rear line of lot No. 14; thence along the line of said lot, N. 4-30 W. 53.5 feet to an iron pin, the rear joint corner of lots Nos. 2 and 3; thence along the joint line of said lots, N. 6-9-49 E. 174 feet to an iron pin on the west side of Arcadia Drive; thence along the line of said drive, S. 25-08 E. 80 feet to the point of beginning.

This Mortgage is junior to that of the Mortgage given by the Mortgagor to The Equitable Life Insurance Society of the United States in the sum of Four Thousand (\$4,000.00) Dollars, dated November 4, 1931, not yet recorded.
