 to be paid February 2, 1933.

with interest thereon from 1st April 2, 1932  
 at the rate of 6% per annum, to be computed and paid annually

George M. Geer Receives  
 until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear  
 interest at same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid, the whole amount evidenced by said note to  
 become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; and in case said note, after its maturity, should  
 be placed in the hands of an attorney for suit or collection, or if before its maturity it should be deemed by the holder thereof necessary for the protection  
 of his interests to place and the holder should place the said note or this mortgage in the hands of an attorney for any legal proceedings, then and in either  
 of said cases the mortgagor promises to pay all costs and expenses including 10 per cent. of the indebtedness as attorneys' fees, this to be added to the mort-  
 gage indebtedness, and to be secured under this mortgage as a part of said debt.

NOW KNOW ALL MEN, that I, the said Stella May Ford,  
Agnes A. Sharpe, in consideration of the said debt and sum of money  
 aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said George M. Geer,  
 according to the terms of the said note, and also in consideration to the further sum of Three Dollars, to me,  
 the said Stella May Ford,  
 in hand well and truly paid by the said Agnes A. Sharpe at and before signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknow-  
 ledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released and by the Presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said George M. Geer,

All that certain lot of land situate in Butler Township, Greenville  
 County, State of South Carolina, about three (3) miles from the  
 Greenville Courthouse on the northerly side of Woods Crossing Road,  
 containing 2.60 acres, more or less, and having, according to plat  
 thereof prepared by Dalton & Neves Oct., 1928, the following metes  
 and bounds, to wit:-

Beginning at a point in the center of said Woods Crossing Road,  
 corner of Greenville Airport property, and running thence along the  
 center of said Woods Crossing Road in a westerly direction along an arc,  
 the chord of which is S. 82-09 W. 230.8 feet to a point in the center  
 of said Woods Crossing Road, corner of the Harley property, thence N.  
 12-20 E. 20 feet to an iron pin in the northern edge of said Woods  
 Crossing Road, thence still along the line of the Harley property  
 N. 12-20 E. 542 feet to an iron pin, thence still along the line of the  
 Harley property, N. 89-15 E. 132 feet to an iron pin, thence S. 88-20  
 E. 82.5 feet to an iron pin, corner of Greenville Airport property,  
 thence along the line of said Greenville Airport property, S. 11-47  
 E. 508 feet to an iron pin in the northern edge of said Woods  
 Crossing Road, thence along the line of said Greenville Airport Property,  
 S. 11-47 E. 20 feet to the point of beginning, and being the same  
 lot of land conveyed to Stella B. Williams by Mamie Wickliffe by  
 deed dated October 24, 1928, and recorded in Vol. 109, page 488, S.

 and other buildings, structures and improvements thereon.
