TO WHOM ALL THESE PRESENTS MAY CONCERN:

I, Katherine J. Garrison SEND GREETING:
 Whereas, I the said Katherine J. Garrison
 in and by my certain Promissory note in writing, of even date with these presents, and
 well and truly indebted to James Kirksey
 in the full and just sum of One Thousand Dollars
 to be paid Five (5) years of use of the 9th day of November Greenville
 with interest thereon from the date of the conveyance of one thousand dollars to me at the rate of two and a half per cent per annum to be computed and paid semi annually on the 1st day of June 1928
 at the rate of two and a half per centum per annum, to be computed and paid
 interest at some rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid, the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due at the option of the holder hereof, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; and in case said note, after its maturity, should be placed in the hands of an attorney for suit or collection, or if before its maturity it should be deemed by the holder thereof necessary for the protection of his interests to place and the holder should place the said note of this mortgage in the hands of an attorney for any legal proceedings, then and in either of said cases the mortgagor promises to pay all costs and expenses including 10 per cent. of the indebtedness for attorneys' fees, this to be added to the mortgage indebtedness, and to be secured under this mortgage as a part of said debt.
 NOW KNOW ALL MEN, that I the said Katherine J. Garrison in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said James Kirksey according to the terms of the said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of three Dollars, to me the said Katherine J. Garrison in hand well and truly paid by the said James Kirksey and before signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released and by the Presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said James Kirksey

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with the buildings and improvements thereon, situate, lying and being in the city of Greenville, County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, on the East side of Augusta Street, being known and designated as a portion of lot No. 1 on plat of property of Parrish & Gower, made by R. E. Dalton, Engineer, May, 1919, said plat being recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, in Plat Book E, at page 136, and having according to said plat the following metes and bounds, courses and distances, to wit:
 Beginning at an iron pin on the East side of Augusta Street, which iron pin is 101.3 feet south of the south-east corner of the intersection of Augusta Street and Prentiss Avenue, and running thence with the East side of Augusta Street, S 47-53 E. 7 1/2 feet to an iron pin, corner of lot now or formerly belonging to J. E. Farquhar; thence with said line, N. 42-24 E. 141.78 feet, more or less, to an iron pin on the west side of a 15 foot alley; thence with the west side of said alley N. 53-03 W. 33.5 feet to an iron pin; thence continuing with said alley N. 43-52 W. 25.9 feet to corner of strip of land heretofore conveyed by me to A. B. Carter; thence S. 47-39 W. 141.3 feet, more or less, to the beginning corner.
 This is the same property conveyed to me by deed of V. O. Garrison, dated September 29, 1923, and recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, in Deeds Volume 90, at Page 179, with the exception of a strip two feet wide sold off by me from the north side of said lot to A. B. Carter, by deed recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, in Deeds Volume 108, at Page 334.
