Whereas, the said D. J. Wall and H. A. Wall, do owe us, the sum of \$335.33, well and truly indebted to us, the sum of \$335.33, in the full and just sum of Three Hundred Thirty-Five and 33/100 Dollars (\$335.33) to be paid One (1) year after date.

with interest thereon from date

at the rate of 8 per centum per annum, to be computed and paid monthly,

until paid in full all interest not paid when due to bear interest at same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid, the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; and in case said note, after its maturity, should be placed in the hands of an attorney for suit or collection, or if before its maturity it should be deemed by the holder thereof necessary for the protection of his interests to place and the holder should place the said note or this mortgage in the hands of an attorney for any legal proceedings, then and in either of said cases the mortgagor promises to pay all costs and expenses including 10 per cent. of the indebtedness as attorneys' fees, this to be added to the mortgage indebtedness, and to be secured under this mortgage as a part of said debt.

Alewine and Ansel Alewine, a Partnership trading as Taylors Lumber Company in hand well and truly paid by the said, at and before signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released and by the presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Mrs. J. W. Alewine, S. W. Alewine and Ansel Alewine, a partnership trading as Taylors Lumber Company their heirs, executors, administrators, successors and assigns: All that lot, tract, or parcel of land on South side of National Highway No. 29, about one mile west of the Town of Taylors near the Greenville-Harrison, being in Chick Springs Township, County and State aforesaid, comprising lands of J. P. Wall lot on the west and other lots of the assignee on the East, and bounded on the North by National Highway No. 29, and on the South by right-of-way of Piedmont and Northern Railroad, and having the following metes and bounds: Beginning on S. P. on South side of Highway on corner of J. P. Wall lot, thence N. 50° E. 80 feet and three inches to S. P. on South side of Highway; thence S. 30° E. 282 feet to right-of-way of the P. & N. Railroad, thence with said right-of-way S. 59 W. 78 feet to S. P. on right-of-way of the P. & N. Railroad, thence N. 39 1/4 W. 269 feet and two inches to the beginning corner, and containing one-half (1/2) acre, more or less, according to survey made by J. Earle Freeman, February 6th, 1934.
