until paid in full all interest not then due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage, said note further providing for an attorney's fee of as reasonable amount

besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to the amount due on the said note, to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part thereof, be collected by an attorney or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by the said note reference being thereunto had, as will more fully appear.

at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these Presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said W. W. Babb, his heirs and assigns,

All that certain piece, parcel, or lot of land, lying and being and situate in Fairview township, County and State aforesaid about 1 mile north of the incorporate limits of the town of Mountain Inn, containing 2 acres more or less. Bounded on the East by lands of Ed Bennett, on the South by Ed Bennett land lands formerly owned by Nelson Gault, on the West by the public Road leading from Greenville.
