with interest thereon, from the date of this note, at the rate of six per cent. per annum to be computed and paid semi-annually, until paid in full all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage, said note further providing for an attorney's fee of

One per cent. (1%) besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to the amount due on the said note, to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part thereof, be collected by an attorney or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by the said note, reference being thereto had, as will more fully appear.

its executors and assigns:

All that certain piece of land or tract of land lying and being situated in Spartan Township, County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, on the Saluda River, near Greenville Road, and containing 136 acres more or less, bounded on the North by lands of J. H. Bennett and E. W. Anderson, on the East by lands of E. W. Meares and Greenville Road, on the South by lands of Henry Stanzell, and on the West by Saluda River and Gadsden Manufacturing Company, and being the same tract of land formerly owned by J. A. Meares by deed recorded in the office of R. M. C. for Greenville County in Book 34, pages 107, 108, and 109, said lands being fully set forth by compass and distances, and metes and bounds upon a plat or same made by William F. Lee, Surveyor, February 2, 1916, copy of which plat is on file with the Federal Land Bank of Columbia, South Carolina.

It is understood between the parties hereto that this mortgage is second in lien to a mortgage given by J. C. Meares to Federal Land Bank of Columbia in the sum of Two Thousand (\$2000.00) Dollars the same being recorded in R. M. C. office for Greenville County in Mortgage Book 112, page 81.
