according to the terms of the said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars, to the said Ralph Leo, in hand well and truly paid by the said Citizens Lumber Co., Inc., 1939,

at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these Presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Citizens Lumber Co., Inc., its successors and assigns, the following described lot: All that certain piece, parcel, or lot of land, beginning being a point situated on Randall Street in the City of Greenville, being known and designated as lot 210.13 of the property of W. Lindsay and Arthur J. Smith, as will appear by reference to plat of said lot recorded in the Office of the Greenville County Clerk in Book H, page 5, and being more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at a stake on Randall Street and running thence S. 1-41 W. 12 $\frac{1}{2}$ feet to an iron pin the place N. 85-39 W. 5 $\frac{1}{2}$ feet to and iron pin; thence S. 1-41 E. 12 $\frac{1}{2}$ feet to iron pin on Randall Street; thence with Randall Street S. 85-39 E. 5 $\frac{1}{2}$ feet to the beginning corner;
