SEND GREETING:

WHEREAS, *J.*, the said *J. P. H. Bradwells*,  
in and by *a* certain *real estate*, note... in writing, of  
even date with these presents, *am*,

*Habson Lumber Company, Inc.*,  
in the full and just sum of *One Thousand Thirty-five and 80/100*  
Dollars, to be paid *November 15<sup>th</sup>, 1921,*

with interest thereon, from *date* at the rate of *8* per cent. per annum to be  
computed and paid *semi-monthly*.

until paid in full all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of  
principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note... to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof,  
who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage, said note further providing for an attorney's fee of *Two and One-half per cent.*

*satisfied and cashed* *7th day of November 1921* besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be  
added to the amount due on the said note..., to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part  
thereof be collected by an attorney or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by the said note..., reference being there-  
unto had, as will more fully appear.

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That *J.*, the said *J. P. H. Bradwells*,

in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said *Habson Lumber Company, Inc.*,

according to the terms of the said note..., and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars, to *me*, the said *P. D. Bradwells*,

in hand well and truly paid by the said *Habson Lumber Company, Inc.*,

at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these Presents do grant, bar-  
gain, sell and release unto the said *Habson Lumber Company,*

All that piece, parcel or lot of land in O'Neal  
Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina  
and having the following Metes and bounds to wit:  
Beginning at an iron gin in the Masteller road  
and running thence S. 64-26 W. 118.36 poles to  
iron gin; thence S. 40 E. 16 poles to iron gin; thence  
N. 64 E. 16 poles to iron gin on said Masteller  
road; thence down said Masteller road N. 35 W.  
17.5 poles to iron gin; the beginning corner. This  
being one acre (the Southeast portion) of tract number  
2 of the Green Hector Estate according to a plat of  
the Estate of Green Hector made by J. T. Justice,  
Surveyor, dated the 28<sup>th</sup> day of September, 1921,  
said tract being recorded in the office of R. M. C.  
for Greenville County in Plat Book #1 at page  
#6 and according to plat and survey of said
