Cannon and the Fountain Inn Oil Works and being the northern portion of the two acre lot conveyed to Mittie E. Jones by J. W. Gray, Master, by deed dated January 14, 1910, recorded in the office for said County in Book 34 at page 367, and being the same conveyed to J. D. Wood by Mittie E. Jones by deed dated July 24, 1912, recorded in said office in Book 17 at page 54, and the same lot of land conveyed to Florence M. Wood by E. Farmer, Master, by deed dated September 23, 1931, to be recorded.

Also, that certain lot of land in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, ~~in the city of Fountain Inn~~, beginning in the center of Main Street, said point being the Southern boundary of the lands of James E.
